Notes: This report is based on evaluation of the product completed in March 2026. Validation was performed up to July 2026.

Evaluation Methods Used: Evaluation of the product involved a combination of manual and functional testing against the applicable success criteria within the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 Conformance Level A and AA and Section 508.
