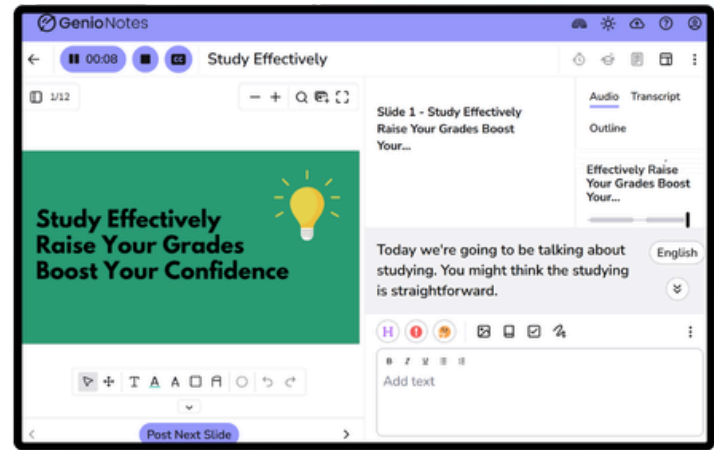


Live Captions

How does Live Captions work in Genio Notes?



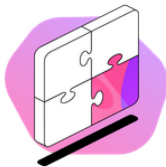
Follow along in real time

Students see a live transcript of spoken content whilst still taking notes and engaging with class content.



Scroll back through captions

Students can scroll back and forward through the full record of captions during a live session, so nothing is missed.



32 languages supported

Live Captions are available in 32 languages, including English, Spanish, Portuguese, French, German and more.



Full transcript after class

After class, students can generate a complete transcript to further support their studies and revision.



Available on mobile

Students can access Live Captions on both desktop and mobile, giving greater flexibility in how they attend and record classes.



Bite-sized captions

Captions appear a couple of lines at a time, keeping the experience focused and easy to follow.
